

Tilly's Crochet Cloche

Adapted from an online pattern from *Interweave Crochet Accessories 2010 Nicole's Cap / how to crochet a beanie: 5 free crochet beanie patterns*



Ludwig's Yarn hand-dyed (100% English Leicester DK Yarn); 196 metres per 100g (less than) 1 ball 100g Our test hat used 89g of yarn.

Hook Size E/4 (3.5 mm). Adjust hook size if necessary to obtain correct gauge.

Notions Yarn needle; stitch marker (m).

Tension 24 Dc and 28 rows = 4" in Dc.

Finished Size. Adult Size 56 cm

Abbreviations V-st: (Trbl, ch 1, Trbl) in indicated st or sp.

The crown of the cloche is worked in a spiral without joining rounds. Place the stitch marker (pm) in first st or ch-1 of every round to mark the beginning of the round.

Hat

Ch 2, 6 Dc in 2nd ch from hook.

Rnd 1: 2 Dc in each Dc around—12 Dc.

Rnd 2: Dc in first Dc, pm (See Notes) *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—18 Dc.

Rnd 3: Dc in first 2 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 2 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—24 Dc.

Rnd 4: Dc in first 3 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 3 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—30 Dc

Rnd 5: Dc in first 4 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 4 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—36 Dc.

Rnd 6: Dc in first 5 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 5 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—42 Dc.

Rnd 7: Dc in first 6 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 6 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—48 Dc.

Rnd 8: Dc in first 7 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 7 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—54 Dc

Rnd 9: Dc in first 8 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 8 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—60 Dc.

Rnd 10: Dc in first 9 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 9 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—66 Dc.

Rnd 11: Dc in first 10 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 10 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—72 Dc.

Rnd 12: Dc in first 11 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 11 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—78 Dc.

Rnd 13: Dc in first 12 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 12 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—84 Dc.

Rnd 14: Dc in first 13 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 13 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—90 Dc.

Rnd 15: Dc in first 14 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 14 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—96 Dc.

Rnd 16: Dc in first 15 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 15 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—102 Dc.

Rnd 17: Dc in first 16 Dc, *2 Dc in next Dc, Dc in next 16 Dc; rep from * to last Dc, 2 Dc in last Dc—108 Dc. Slip stitch to join.

The next rounds are worked as complete rounds : slip st to first ch of previous rnd or to top of first trbl.

Rnd 18: 3 ch, 2 trbl in next Dc, * sk next Dc, Trbl in next Dc; 3 trbl in next Dc rep from * to last 2 sts, sk next Dc, slip st into top chn of first group of trebles.

Rnd 19: Ch 1, *sk next trbl, trbl in next trbl, sk next trbl, V-st (see Abbreviations) in next trbl; rep from * to last 2 sts, sk last trbl, V-st in last trbl.

Rnd 20: Ch 1, sk first ch-1 sp, V-st in ch-1 at center of next V-st, *ch 1, V-st in next ch-1 sp; rep from * around.

Rnd 21: Sk first ch-1 sp, *V-st in next ch-1 sp; rep from * around.

Rnds 22–29: V-st in each ch-1 sp around.

Rnd 30: (2trbl, ch 1, 2 trbl) in each ch-1 sp around. Slip st to top of first trbl.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
